## CAN THE "SLIDERS" EVER GO HOME AGAIN?

### NEW SEASON OF 22 ORIGINAL EPISODES OF POPULAR SCIENCE-FICTION SERIES "SLIDERS" PREMIERES JUNE 8 ON SCI-FI CHANNEL

#### Jerry O'Connell, Cleavant Derricks and Kari Wuhrer Return, Introducing Charlie O'Connell as Pivotal New Character

What if you found a portal to a parallel universe? What if you could slide into a thousand different worlds. Same year, different person. What if you found your way home, but home was now *occupied by the Kromaggs*?

In the new fourth season of the science fiction/adventure series "Sliders," premiering on June 8 at 9 p.m. ET on **Sci-Fi Channel**, the explorers temporarily make their way back to their original Earth only to find that it has been taken over by a malevolent breed of humanity called the Kromaggs. With a revamped timer in hand, the Sliders embark on a new mission to locate Quinn Mallory's brother, their parents and ultimately conquer the Kromaggs. In addition, actor Charlie O'Connell (Jerry O'Connell's real-life brother) joins the cast early in the season as Colin Mallory.

Jerry directs several, but produces all. The wording is misleading.

**Jerry O'Connell** ("Scream 2," "Jerry Maguire," "Joe's Apartment"), who produces and directs several episodes this season, stars as Quinn Mallory; **Cleavant Derricks** ("Something Wilder") stars as Rembrandt "Crying Man" Brown; **Kari Wuhrer** ("Kissing A Fool") stars as Maggie Beckett; and newcomer **Charlie O'Connell** stars as Colin Mallory.

"Sliders" follows the adventures of a young team of explorers who travel through a sliding vortex to parallel dimensions of Earth. Each unpredictable slide places them in precarious circumstances packed with near death encounters, technology gone awry, and polarized societies. The new season will feature more distinctly bizarre earth worlds as the Sliders fight the oppressive Kromaggs. Their adventures include: encounters with religious fundamentalists who indoctrinate their followers in a deadly ritual; meeting ghostly images of themselves in a haunted hotel; a world population that slides to a parallel earth, with the exception of Quinn's double; a mysterious conversion that turns the Sliders into computer images; and a confrontation with the ultimate Kromagg death weapon.

Sci-Fi Channel's web site, "The Dominion," is working closely with "Sliders" producers and writers to feature weekly tie-ins to the episodes that will include games, puzzles or extensions to recreate and enhance "sliding" for the web user.

Sci-Fi Channel, which purchased the rights to all previous 48 episodes, is currently airing selected encore episodes. "Sliders" debuted on the Fox Television Network on March 22, 1995, and completed its third season May 16.

Created by Robert K. Weiss and Tracy Tormé, "Sliders" is produced by St. Clare Entertainment in association with Universal Television. David Peckinpah is the Executive Producer; Bill Dial is Co-Executive Producer; Marc Scott Zicree, Jerry O'Connell and Ed Ledding are the Producers; and Chris Black is Co-Producer. Tracy Tormé is Executive Consultant.
